BALLET - Ages 5+, .75-3.5 hr/week

Ballet is the basis for nearly every style of dance technique and is foundational in a student's formal dance training. **It is highly recommended that students ages 6-7 take one year of Ballet/Jazz before Ballet IA.**

Ballet IIB, by recommendation, 1.25 hr/week

Students must have completed Ballet IIA to take this class.

Ballet III, by recommendation, 1.25 hrs/week

Students must have completed Ballet IIB to take this class, which will include pre-pointe strengthening exercises. We strongly recommend Modern and Contemporary/Jazz Fusion for this level.

Ballet IV, by recommendation, 3 hrs/week

This class is designed for students who have graduated from our Ballet III level or by teacher evaluation. Dancers will develop skill, creativity, and dance knowledge. This class includes pre-pointe or pointe, depending on the student's personal level. We request that these students also take Modern and Jazz. Please be sure on the Parent Portal that you enroll in both days.

Mondays 5:45-7:15 pm AND Fridays 5:15-6:45 pm South

Ballet V, by recommendation, 3-4.5 hrs/week

This class is designed for students who have graduated from Ballet IV. We request that these dancers also take Jazz and Modern. Please be sure on the Parent Portal that you enroll in multiple days.

Optional: add Fridays 5:15-6:45 pm South

Ballet VI, by recommendation, 4.5 hrs/week

This class is designed for students who have graduated from Ballet V. We request that these dancers also take Jazz and Modern. Please be sure on the Parent Portal that you enroll in all three days.

JAZZ/CONTEMPORARY - Ages 5+, .75 - 1 hr/week

Jazz is an energetic American form of dance that originated from a blend of African and European dance styles. Learn jazz steps and technique with an emphasis on developing flexibility and strength. Jazz steps are the basis for much of the choreography in musical theatre and contemporary dance.

MUSICAL THEATRE DANCE - Ages 12-18, 1 hr/week

Dancers will learn Broadway-inspired combinations, must-know vocabulary, and tips and tricks for musical theatre performances, auditions, and more! This class is for those who want to see improvements in their performance quality, coordination, and ability to memorize movement sequences quickly. No dance experience necessary. Dancers are highly recommended to take the semester's musical, improv, and/or their appropriate acting level class.

MODERN - Ages 10+, 1 hr/week

Modern dance focuses on the dancer's relationship with the floor and the movements tend to be angular and rhythmic. This form of dance is often used to convey intense emotion and can be a powerful storytelling tool. **At least one year of prior formal dance experience is highly recommended.**

SCHOOL OF THEATRE

Acting and theatre education helps students academically, especially in the areas of reading comprehension, narrative writing, reasoning, memorization, and social interaction. Theatre is not only fun, it's practical! In our program, students are trained in improvisation, speech, movement exercises, scene work, and acting theory.

WRIGHT! – Ages 8-17

The epic story of The Wright Brothers and their flying machine comes to life in modern day rap, song and narration. Told by a group of intrepid reporters who are tailing the inventors, we discover that, as incredible as Orville and Wilbur's feat of inventing the first successful airplane was, the real lesson may well be the example they demonstrated by building their future and dreams on higher ground, and setting their sights up and not down. TUITION, REGISTRATION, AND COSTUME FEES:

Payment: Monthly tuition is based on total number of classes for the year and divided evenly. It does not vary during holiday months. Payment for the term must be made **with pre-authorized credit/debit card payments or postdated checks at the time of registration.** For spring, one-time registration fees are \$20 per class with a maximum of \$80 in registration fees per family. Costume fees are \$80 per student per class for spring recital.
